Mission Report

2016 has gotten off to a great start and I want to tell you about it. In January we traveled with MedReach Ministry to Uganda. This is a ministry that I travel with each year to teach pastors while they serve people in the bush areas of Uganda with medical help and service.

We were in a small village called Kinene in the Nwoya District of Northern Uganda. We arrived as usual at the Entebbe Airport just outside Kampala and then traveled north about 8 hours. There was a wonderful team of volunteers from MedReach who gave themselves that week ministering to 2000 men, women and children who needed basic medical and hygiene attention.

In the weeks prior to the mission, as they advertised in the surrounding area that medical facilities would be available, they also invited the pastors from that region to come receive medical attention as well as Biblical/pastoral training. The goal for the week was 40 pastors and we had 41 to attend, some from as far away as 60 miles! It was a wonderful week. These were young, energetic pastors who were eager to learn and willing to work. We were able to have my teaching materials translated and printed in the Acholi language so that the pastors could have them in their own dialect.

During the week we also saw teams of American

volunteers and Ugandan workers go out into the bush villages each night to pre-chosen sites to show the Jesus Film. According to the reports from MedReach officials here are the total results for the week:

5209 total attendance for medical ministry and Jesus Film.

2987 responded to the Gospel.

630 women were instructed in ladies hygiene.

623 pairs of reading glasses were distributed.

250 mosquito nets distributed.

450 bags of flour grain were given to families.

Hundreds of toboggans, blankets, children's clothes handed out.

19 Study Bibles given to pastors courtesy of members at Southside Baptist Church in Savannah and the LifeWay Stores in Savannah and Valdosta.

One of the greatest experiences I had on this mission was to distribute Study Bibles to a number of the pastors in the class. The members at Southside Baptist Church in Savannah and the LifeWay Stores in Savannah and Valdosta provided 19 Study Bibles that I was able to give to 19 deserving pastors. I wish you could have been with me to see the look of disbelief and delight on their faces when I gave them their bibles.

It was a joy and privilege for me to participate in this week of ministry in Uganda, and I couldn't have done

it without each of you who faithfully support and pray for Wayne Dorsett Ministries. Thank you!

Ministry Needs

When I journey to these places to teach pastors, I must provide all the financial resources needed to fund the event, including the venue, food, transportation reimbursement and lodging for pastors, printed materials. On a recent trip to Tanzania they told me that ours was the only ministry that had ever provided for all the expenses of a conference. Other ministries charged a fee to the pastors and this eliminates many from being able to attend. Because of your faithful support we are able to provide for pastors who otherwise could not afford the cost of attendance. Thank you for giving so faithfully and generously. The cost for a 4-day seminar is \$5,000.
